

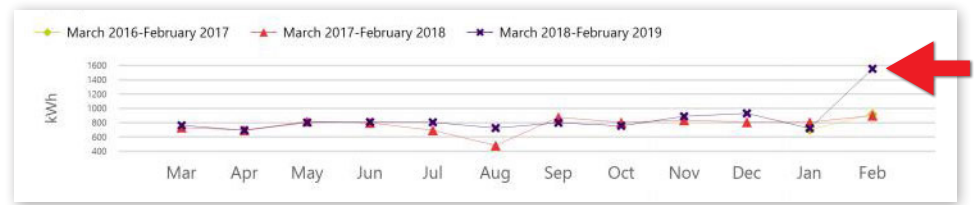
Three Things To Do Tomorrow To Save Energy

1 Report-12 Visual Bill Audit

Visually audit the latest bill for each meter.

Use one of these filters to limit the bills in the report:

- Billing Period equals (select one recent month)
- Bill Entry Date (select a recent range of dates)
- Batch (select one recent Batch Code)



Look for: Rightmost **purple X**. The bill being audited is **always** the **purple X** on the far right. Everything else is history.

2 Customize and Share a Dashboard

Easily share information with your energy-using constituents.

Develop an energy efficiency culture with support from leadership, awareness campaigns, reminders, and feedback.

Copy a sample dashboard. Rename the dashboard and share it with the public.

3 View Outliers in Benchmarks

Building Groups

- Cost/Area
- Use/Area
- Peak Demand/Area

Meter Groups

- Unit Cost
- Peak Demand

Look for outliers. Investigate!

Use the icon to remove a group member from benchmarks and calculations.

Select a display option from the drop-down.

High to Low

Low to High

Scatter Plot: Focus on upper right quadrant

Savings Opportunities: Savings potential if reduced to the group average

Details: Helps to find members with high values in both dimensions
